## **Violent Rituals of Exclusion: Women, Dissidence and Punishment under Franco**

**Lecture by Cinta Ramblado Minero, University of Limerick, Ireland**

**Dr. Cinta Ramblado Minero** is Head of Spanish at the University of Limerick, Ireland. Recipient of several research grants from the Irish and Spanish governments, she currently devotes her research efforts to projects focusing on gender, memory and representation. The lecture will analyze the meaning and purpose of the feminization of politics and repression in the Francoist state, especially at times of instability, by offering a socio-historical overview of the different methods of repression used against women. Dr. Ramblado will also explore how dissident/excluded women coped with the punitive politics of the Franco regime, while emphasizing the ways in which they rebelled against the dictatorship in order to maintain a sense of identity, which, despite the efforts of the regime, has survived strongly to this day.
